SPECTATORS INFO

TICKETS

- **ENTRY TICKETS FOR ALL SESSIONS MUST BE PURCHASED ONLINE ONLY AT**

- **TICKETS CANNOT BE PURCHASED ON THE DOOR AT ANY VENUE**
- Tickets can be either saved to your phone or printed off – The QR code needs to be visible as this will be scanned at the entrance to each session

TICKETS AT BASILDON SPORTING VILLAGE

- Spectator Entry is usually around 15 minutes before the start of the warm up
- All tickets for Basildon Sporting Village are session specific therefore you must have a ticket for EACH session you wish to spectate at
- Please have the CORRECT session ticket ready to show at the door either a paper version (with QR code) or on your phone or tablet so as to avoid hold ups at the door
- Reserved seating is used at Basildon for ALL sessions except 1500 and 800- Please sit in the seat that you are allocated
- Blue Badge holders need to purchase a seat online and then email essexswimming@btopenworld.com attaching a copy of their blue badge and they will be allocated a disabled seat to replace their purchased seat
- The balcony will be completely cleared between each session – Please leave as quickly as possible after presentations have finished so that we are able to get spectators in for the next session

- **Entry for Spectators at Basildon is via the Athletic Track only**- If you try to enter via the main foyer, you will be turned away
- Swimmers 14 and under must not be left unsupervised in the venue when not on poolside under any circumstances
- Swimmers are only permitted on poolside when they are swimming in that session
- There will be a 'swimmers waiting area' in the sports hall at Basildon BUT swimmers using this area MUST be supervised by a club representative or parent at all times

TICKETS AT LAC

- **ENTRY FOR ALL EVENTS AT LONDON AQUATIC CENTRE IS VIA THE UPPER SIDE ENTRANCE ONLY**- This can be accessed by walking round the side of the building to the right from the 'old' main upper level main entrance- this will be signposted – there will be no entry to swimmers, coaches or spectators from the lower level entrance- There are plenty of seats available at LAC therefore queuing is not necessary
- Spectator entry is from 7.30am
- All tickets for LAC are for the whole day and can be used for any session – seating at LAC is not reserved and you can choose where you sit upon entry
- There are plenty of disabled seats at LAC therefore we do not reserve these in advance
- Swimmers will be issued with a coloured wristband that will enable them to wait on the balcony between sessions – **ALL SWIMMERS AGED 14 AND UNDER MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT ON POOLSIDE**

At both venues you will receive a coloured hand stamp that will be checked as you move around the venues

FACEMASKS MUST BE WORN IN SPECTATOR GALLERIES AT BOTH VENUES

- Fold up chairs are not permitted on the Spectators Gallery at ANY Centre
- ALL spectators will require an entry ticket including children
- Parents are not permitted in the Changing Village or on Poolside at ANY centre
- Spectators are not permitted to take food or drink onto the spectator's gallery at LAC
- Queuing is not necessary
- Spectator tickets at Basildon are limited to 2 per swimmer (EXCEPT 1500 AND 800)
- Queuing at LAC is NOT necessary as there are plenty of seats for everyone

SWIMMERS INFO

Basildon

- **Entry for Swimmers at Basildon is via the Athletic Track only-** If you try to enter via the main foyer, you will be turned away
- **ONLY SWIMMERS SWIMMING IN THE RUNNING SESSION ARE PERMITTED ON POOLSIDE-** Swimmers must leave poolside as soon as they have finished their events for that session
- Entry for swimmers for the next session will be during presentations for the previous session **ONLY**
- The marshalling area at Basildon will be around the Teaching pool
- Swimmers 14 and under must not be left unsupervised in the venue when not on poolside under any circumstances
- There will be a 'swimmers waiting area' in the sports hall at Basildon **BUT** swimmers using this area **MUST** be supervised by a club representative or parent at all times
- **MOBILE PHONES ARE NOT PERMITTED 'OUT' ON POOLSIDE OR IN THE CHANGING VILLAGE AT ANY TIME**
- Drawstring bags **ONLY** are permitted on poolside- this will be strictly monitored
- Poolside chairs are not permitted on poolside at Basildon

SWIMMERS INFO

LAC

- **ENTRY FOR ALL EVENTS AT LONDON AQUATIC CENTRE IS VIA THE UPPER SIDE ENTRANCE ONLY- This can be accessed by walking round the side of the building to the right from the 'old' main upper level main entrance- this will be signposted – there will be no entry to swimmers, coaches or spectators from the lower level entrance-**
- Swimmer entry is from 7.00am
- **ONLY SWIMMERS SWIMMING IN THE CURRENT RUNNING SESSION WILL BE PERMITTED ON POOLSIDE- Entry for swimmers for the next session will be during presentations for the previous session ONLY**

- Swimmers will be issued with a coloured wristband that will enable them to wait on the balcony between sessions – **ALL SWIMMERS AGED 14 AND UNDER MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT AT ALL TIMES WHEN NOT ON POOLSIDE**
- **MOBILE PHONES ARE NOT PERMITTED 'OUT' ON POOLSIDE OR IN THE CHANGING VILLAGE AT ANY TIME**
- Drawstring bags **ONLY** are permitted on poolside- this will be strictly monitored
- **Poolside chairs ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED AT LAC ONLY as there will be no other seating supplied**
